The 2023-2025 Farmington Garden Club Leadership Team is as follows.



NEW CITY ENFORCEMENT

- As of this past July, Hampton is issuing warnings, and then fines, for violations of new trash rules that were passed into law this year. Please consult https://hampton.gov/4083/Trash-Rules for the full list of rules. Note that first time violators will receive a warning, second-time violators will be fined \$50, and subsequent violators will be fined \$75.
- The City of Hampton is slapping speeders on Farmington Blvd with an add'l \$250 fine on top of the regular speeding penalty. Please note your speed in the neighborhood: we have many pedestrians, bicyclists, and children sharing the road with our vehicles.





FCA ELECTIONS ANNOUNCEMENT



FCA Officers are elected every two years, and this coming January we will be having an election. Each member of a paid household is eligible to run for an officer position. Candidates who have currently announced their intention to run are: Connie Vatsa for President, Mike Chapman for 1st Vice President, Alex Norwood for 2nd Vice President, and Aaron Giles for Treasurer. Voters can bring in printed ballots received by email. For voters who do not have access to a printer, ballots will be available at the voting location (likely Northampton Community Center).

We also have a few non-officer positions available on the Executive Board, including a youth member position. Please let us know if you are interested in serving.

Dr. Shar, an engineer working for the city of Hampton, kicked off the Sept 27th FCA General Membership meeting by introducing the attendees to a whole team of folks studying the Farmington Canal issue that so directly impacts the residents of Farmington. He explained the studies that had been conducted on the canal, including the effects of erosion, overgrowth, and bank failure. He went on to describe the plans the city was making to improve the canal, resulting in better drainage and less flooding in our streets.



To wrap up the discussion, three breakout groups were created, since the impacts of the canal project varied depending on where in Farmington one lives.
